Indonesia is one of the world's fastest growing countries, which is constantly expanding into the larger world market. ASEAN countries are considered growing markets for international trade and attract international investors expanding their businesses.

According to IMF data in April 2019, Indonesia is the only ASEAN country to be listed as the top 20 wealthiest countries in the world based on GDP. Due to its strategic position, Indonesia is considered a hub for economic and business activities in the ASEAN region. Indonesia is a great place to learn how business is done in this part of the world since students can get a firsthand perspective of the culture and the way of life in an ASEAN country.

Jakarta is our exciting mega-city! While preserving many cultural aspects unique to our city and Indonesia, students can find almost all modern amenities of other large prominent cities here: museums, vibrant restaurants, outdoor escapes, and malls. Jakarta is located on the Indonesian island of Java, it is the capital and the largest city of Indonesia. The number of people residing in greater Jakarta is estimated at 23 million, making it as the 21st largest city in the world. As a megapolitan city, Jakarta is filled with hustle and bustle of everyday life. Jakarta Government has implemented a better system recently to provide good public transportation facilities. Though taxis and busses are available, other option such as motorbike taxi (*ojek*) is available for faster journeys through jakarta. In March 2019, the new MRT system has officially launched for the convenience of the Jakarta people. LRT system is also being launched to give more convenient access for commuters between Jakarta and its suburbs.

Jakarta is a gateway access to you to explore exotic well-known travel destinations in the Indonesian archipelago. Be prepared to have a weekend getaway strolling on the beaches of Bali, snorkeling in the crystal-clear water of Bunaken, hiking on the majestic mount Bromo, being amazed with the historical architecture of Borobudur temple, and much more.

With all the exciting things Jakarta and Indonesia may offer to students, living cost in Indonesia is actually not that expensive. USD 6,000 annually should be sufficient for students to spend on accommodation, food, transportation, study materials and of course groceries, and modest travelling.

STUDENT SUPPORT



International Student Support

A dedicated officer - International Student Engagement Counselor, is available to help, accompany, support, and assist the new international students' transitions in adapting to the new university environment, and monitor the students' well-being in collaboration with other related student affairs units. Our International Student Engagement Counselor helps students to get connected with each other and facilitates necessary support events. Our International Student Engagement Counselor will also facilitate our scholarship awardees with the scholarship benefits.



Academic Support

Students are free to access our <u>Library and Knowledge Center</u> for resources, and develop their Indonesian fluency with the embedded Indonesian <u>language classes</u>. Our lecturers are also open to discussions and academic assistance needed by our students. Most of our international students have had positive experiences with how friendly and helpful our lecturers have been. Students requiring further support in their academic progress can request mentors and participate in tutoring classes.



Counseling & Disabilities Support

Students' well-being is at the heart of the study experience as it contributes to students' success. We provide assistance and services for students in both academic and non-academic matters and conduct various self-development activities to support students during their study at BINUS UNIVERSITY. Our supporting units consist of: Counseling Services with a qualified psychologists, Mentoring Services, and Disability Services, available in campuses and in Hall of Residence.



Student Engagement, Student Activities & Enrichment Experience

We believe that enrichment activities outside the campus are as important as in-class learning. Students can participate in many student activities by joining various <u>student clubs</u> that cater to passions, hobbies, and interests, from arts, sports, technology, religious-based activities, or putting their academic passions into practice. Those who wish to hone their entrepreneurial skill can join activities from our entrepreneurship incubation center, Catalyst for Innovation, Design, Entrepreneurship, and Research (CIDER). While those interested in community development activities can take part in volunteering activities organized by Teach for Indonesia (TFI).



Visa and Immigration Support

BINUS UNIVERSITY will be the visa sponsor for the international students coming with C316 ITAS (study visa). Our International Office has been assisting international students to process their immigration to Indonesia. Dedicated officers will advise and guide students on study permit processing, Indonesian visas and temporary stay permit (ITAS). The team also provides assistance for international students who enter Indonesia with different type of visa to switch to BINUS UNIVERSITY visa sponsorship, extend expired ITAS, and process visa closures once students have finished their study with BINUS. The International Office also organizes excursions and student exchange/study abroad program for our students.

OFF-CAMPUS ACCOMODATION

Most of the local students stay in *'kost'* (shared houses). Apartments and student rooms known as *'kost'* are off-campus accommodation types available in the residential areas around BINUS campuses. Students can rent apartments or single rooms in the dormitory pavilions and private homes. - ⁴ Indonesian Temporary Stay Permit (ITAS) process requires Telex, VITAS, MERP (Multiple Re-Entry Permit) as well as the ITAS itself.
- ⁵ The fee stated is for 2-year ITAS validity period. Shorter ITAS validity durations have different fees applied.

*longer process for calling visa and delicate countries **after arrival The whole visa process can take up to 1-3 months in total, if students have submitted the complete documents.

Important Notes

- Indonesian law does not allow employment of foreigners under student visa.
- Students **must present themselves** to the locally governed immigration office to process biometric record and obtain their KITAS.
- Currently there are **no new issuance** of visa applications for study purposes
- Foreigners need to have vaccination certificate prior to entering Indonesia when the borders are opened
- Should there be any mandatory quarantine from the government, applicants needs to **cover the quarantine fees on their own**.



CLAIMING COMISSION

BINUS UNIVERSITY will process commission payments for students who have applied via our representatives and who go on to register with us. You will be asked to send your commission invoices to us in September for programs which begin in the Fall term, as well as pre-sessional programs, and February for programs which begin in the Spring term.

1. ADMISSIONS

How long is the admission process?

Once your required documents is complete, the process until issuance of Letter of Acceptance up tp 3 (three) weeks. If you are scholarship applicants, the scholarship announcement will be by the end of July.

Is there any application fee prior to the registration? There is no application fee prior to the registration.

Do I need to be able to speak Bahasa Indonesia to study at BINUS UNIVERSITY?

No. However, having the ability to speak in Bahasa or knowing simple expressions in Indonesian might give you an advantage in your social life.

Are there any age restrictions to study at BINUS UNIVERSITY?

There are no age restriction to study at BINUS UNIVERSITY, however, scholarship applicants will be subjected to each of the programs' preference. This is due to the curriculum in which the students need to take an "Internship" course, and companies rarely take on mature students as their interns.

Do I need to purchase health insurance?

Yes, it is mandatory to have health insurance during your study in Indonesia. You can purchase the insurance to company that BINUS arrange or you can purchase it on your own.

2. INDONESIA & JAKARTA

How safe is Indonesia and Jakarta?

Generally speaking, Jakarta is a safe place to live but, like any large city, students should be savvy and take precautions for their safety as they would do anywhere else.

How affordable is it to live in Jakarta?

Living cost in Jakarta and in Indonesia are generally considered to be very affordable. The city is considered affordable all while offering all the networking perks of international programs in a metropolitan city with a vibrant digital economy. The cost of living in Jakarta, of course, depends on the kind of lifestyle you have. For your reference, please read <u>here</u>.





What kind of weather is it in Indonesia? Do I need to bring a coat?

Indonesia has a tropical climate and the weather is hot and humid all year round, but cooler inland than along the coastal regions. The high temperatures and humidity are certainly something that takes getting used to for foreign students moving to Indonesia from cooler climates.

The country doesn't have the four distinct seasons, with temperatures staying quite constant throughout the year; coastal regions average around 28°C and the inland and mountain areas average around 26°C year-round.

What kind of culture shock that I might experience in Indonesia?

Every international student might experience different types of culture shock in Indonesia, you can read more about culture shocks in the **article here**.

Is it easy to find halal food?

As Indonesia's population is mostly Moslems (especially in Jakarta), halal food is available relatively everywhere.



Does BINUS have any international student bodies? How can I get help settling in?

International students are welcomed to join and participate in various student clubs and activities that they are passionate about, and mingle with the local students. BINUS organizes an international student communication group, as well as arranging engagement events to help students settling in and getting to know each other better. There are no specific international students' student bodies.

How friendly are the lecturers?

Our lecturers are happy to help students develop their passions and academic areas of interests, giving necessary academic guidance needed to make sure students can graduate on time. Previous students had also made a lifetime connection with our lecturers.

What activities can I do outside campus?

There are a lot of activities students can explore, from volunteering opportunities, joining or create development workshops, or do sports and arts, go sightseeing, travel and experience different places in Jakarta and Indonesia, and many more. We also organize excursions and outings for the students, or check this website for more activities and events students can join.

Is it possible to do internship at companies during semester?

Some of our programs have embedded internship enrichment opportunities during the third year of study, where students can apply for placements in our selected industry partners. Some of our international students have also volunteering in teaching English, or deliver workshops with local NGO's or communities. Note that beside study-related internships and volunteering, paid jobs are prohibited due to student visa's restriction.



Is there any support given in case I face difficulties in learning?

Our dedicated, qualified counselors in Student Advisory and Support Center in each campuses will be able to identify, guide, and provide the supports needed, either it's academic or non-academic related. Students are welcomed to book a private, personal counseling sessions on their life and studies. International students can also ask for guidance from our dedicated International Student Engagement Counselor if they need assistance with their transition to university, studies, or non-academic related issues that affect their learning.

What kind of supports are available for international students?

International students can also ask for guidance from our dedicated International Student Engagement Counselor if they need assistance with their transition to university, studies, or non-academic related issues that affect their learning, and connect them with supporting units needed. International students are gathered and exposed with additional engagement activities to help them build friendships and peer-to-peer support systems.

After graduation, can I find job in Indonesia?

Yes, however, international students under student visa are expected to leave Indonesia by the end of their study (I.e. after judicium process/completing thesis defense and graduation requirements). If students plan to work in Indonesia, students will need to find a company that will sponsor their work visa in Indonesia. Note that students cannot work under student visa and need to switch to work visa to be able to work in Indonesia.

4. BINUS SQUARE (BSQ)

Can I live together with my "partner" in the dormitory?

Unfortunately, no, you are not allowed to live with your boyfriend/girlfriend, or your family (spouses, children) at the dormitories. There will be a separate tower for female boarders and male boarders.

Can I stay with my chosen friends or friends from the same country as me?

We encourage students to mingle and make friends with people from different backgrounds. If you have uncomfortable experiences with your allocated roommates, you can always reach the dormitories team to shuffle your roommates.

How safe it is to stay in the dormitories?

The safety and health of our boarders are the top priority. The building is equipped with CCTVs and 24-hour security guards standby. In COVID-19 situation, strict health protocols and regular disinfestations of public areas are also in place.

What to do if I feel homesick?

We understand it is tough to deal with homesickness. International students are welcomed to reach our International Student Engagement counselors, or reach our counselors in SASC or PDC at BSQ for supports and counseling needed.



5. VISA & IMMIGRATION

Are international students holding student visa able to work while studying?

Students are prohibited to work under a student visa. International students coming in with other types of visa might be able to work while studying upon meeting the conditions of their visas.

Can I study using a different type of visa?

Yes. Some international students have been studying with investor visas, family visas, and diplomatic visas as they have previously resided in Indonesia under different reasons and decided to study afterwards. However, we encourage international students to process student visas.

How long can I stay in Indonesia after graduation?

You can stay in Indonesia until your ITAS is expired, however, it is encouraged that international students return to their home countries once they have finished with their graduation requirements. Please note that BINUS sponsorship cuts off upon student's judicium completion (approx. 1 month after thesis defense completion).
